Dear Parent/carers,

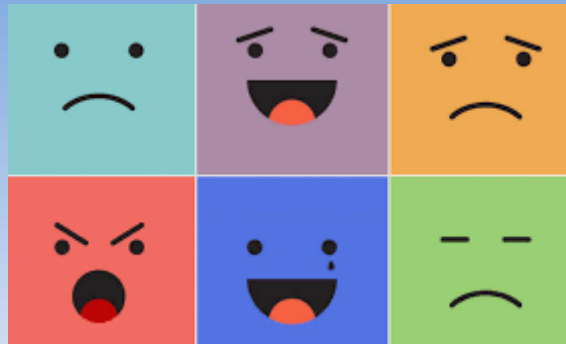

In PSHE, we have shared information about ourselves and talked about different feelings and emotions. We use 'check ins' to share our thoughts and what we have been doing over the weekends.



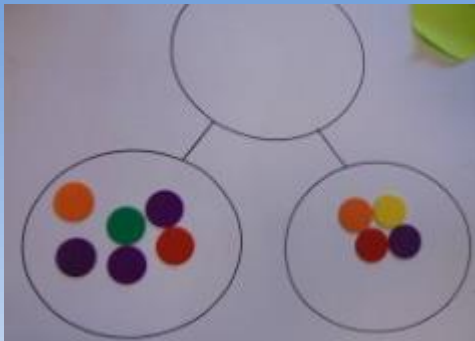
# Literacy
