Thank you for your continued support.

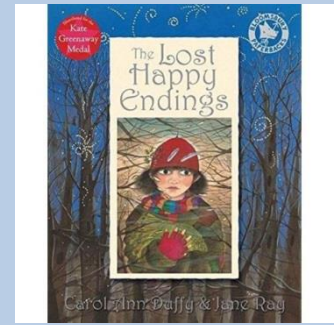

# Literacy

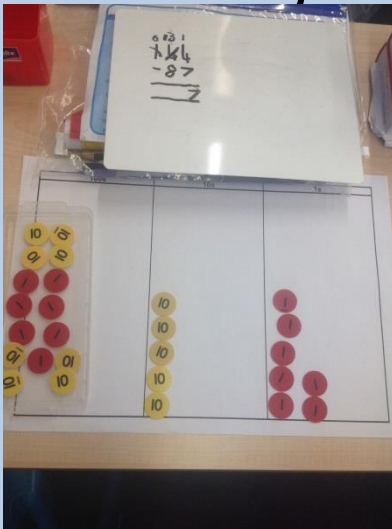
