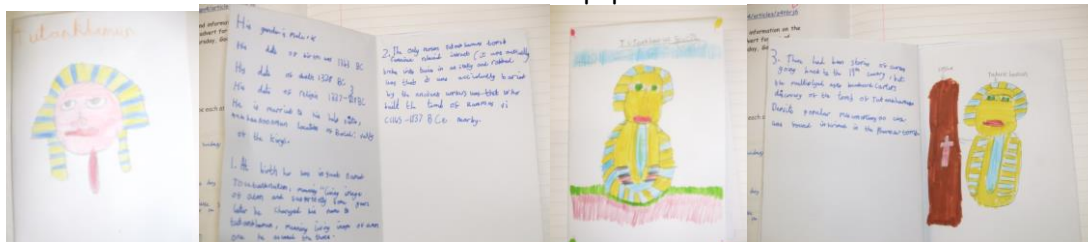
Reception
