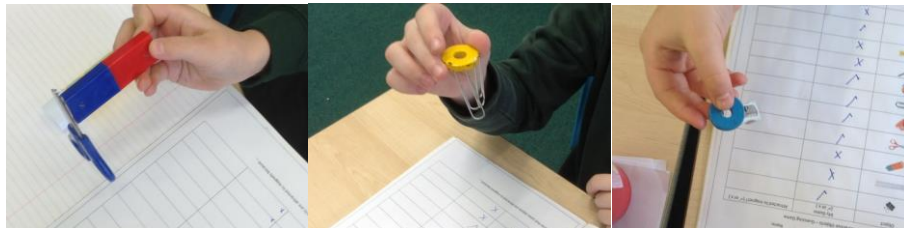
See you back in school on Tuesday
