I hope you have a great weekend with your families.

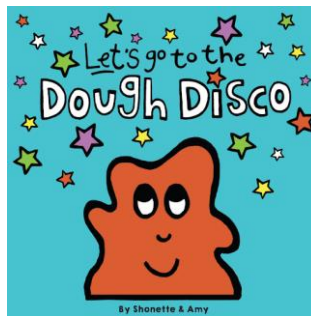
