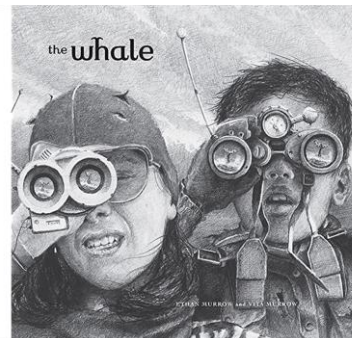
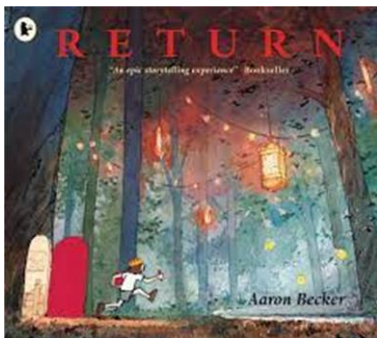
### Key Stage 1

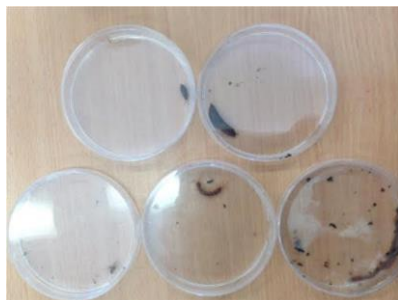
### Lower KS2
