I would also like to pass my congratulations on to the Year 4 Football Team for having a great attitude and trying their best in their match this week - well done!

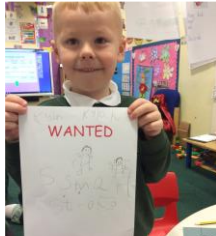
