I hope you have a great weekend!

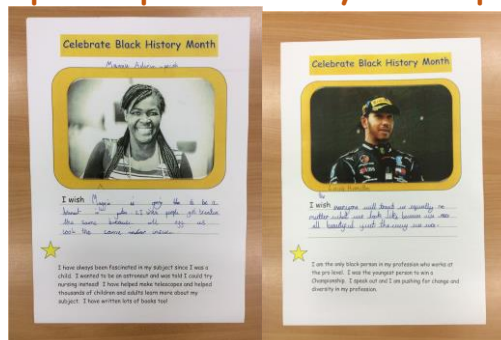

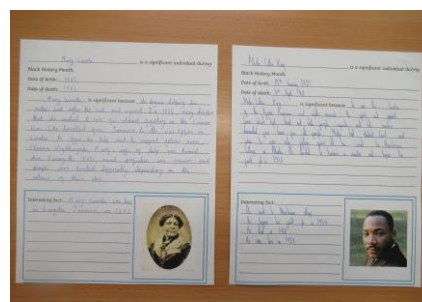
In EYFS, we celebrated black history month by exploring famous black men and women. We looked at different art work created by famous black artists and even tried to create our own African Aboriginal Art. We discussed the importance of being kind to others no matter what they look like and treating others how we would want to be treated.



In LKS2, we celebrated Black History Month on Monday. First, we listened to a message from Baroness Floella Benjamin DBE about the importance of this event. We looked at a number of Black British people who are making history right now in different professions and the ways in which they are doing this. Then, we discussed what the children wished for in the future where we live in a society that celebrates equality, tolerance and acceptance. The children completed posters ready for display.



In UKS2, we celebrated Black History Month by creating biographies of famous black people in history. The children learnt how many black people have changed the world for the better including: Martin Luther King, Rosa Park, Mary Seacole, Diane Abbott and Marcus Rashford. The children also discussed how people have been mistreated due to the colour of their skin and that this must change.
