I hope you all had a great Christmas and New Year!


It is so lovely to have all the children back in School, happy and willing to learn.

Please enjoy reading the following pages to see what activities the children have been involved in this week.



Nursery


We have enjoyed welcoming 6 new children to Nursery this week; it's exciting to have more friends to play with.


