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
Dear Parent/Carer,


## Key Stage 1

## LKS2

Year 3 and 4 have been learning about the Northern Lights in English this week. The children have also written fact files, designed promotional posters and learned some interesting facts about the Northern Lights.



### Upper Key Stage 2

This week the children have thoroughly enjoyed studying poetry. 5LC have written poems based on 'City Jungle' showing they understand and can use personification. Today, they will be performing their poems for each other. 5/6M and 6J have looked at the classic poem 'Tyger, Tyger' by William Blake. They have learnt about rhyming schemes, imagery and themes within the poem. 
