Welcome back after a very windy, blustery half term!


The children have had a fantastic week back enjoying Art and Design activities - please look at the following pages to see what your child may have been involved in.



### LKS2

Thank you to our children and families for all the Morrisons vouchers. We are pleased to inform you that we have managed to purchase lots of new gardening tools for our growing areas.


