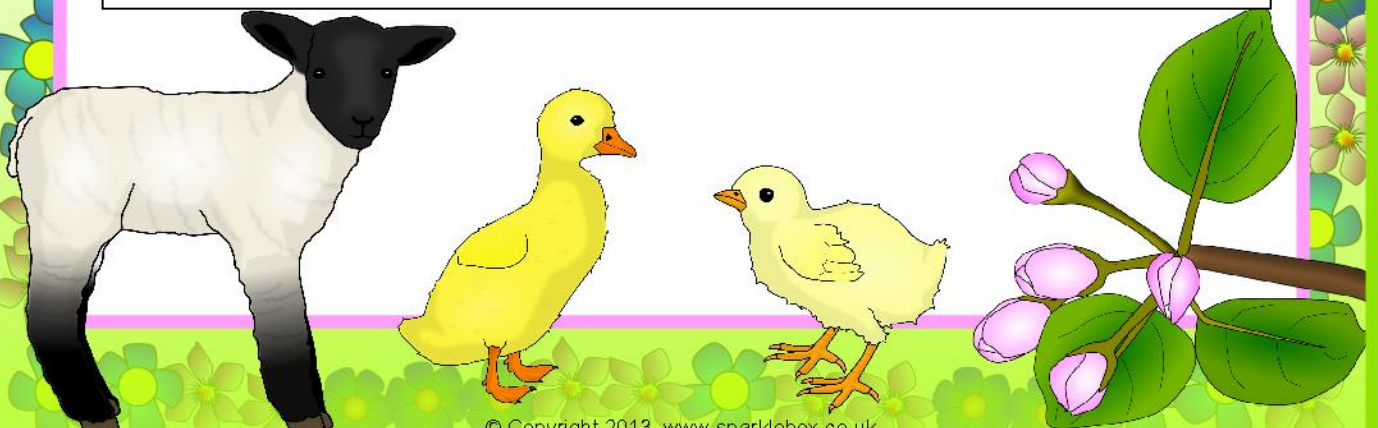

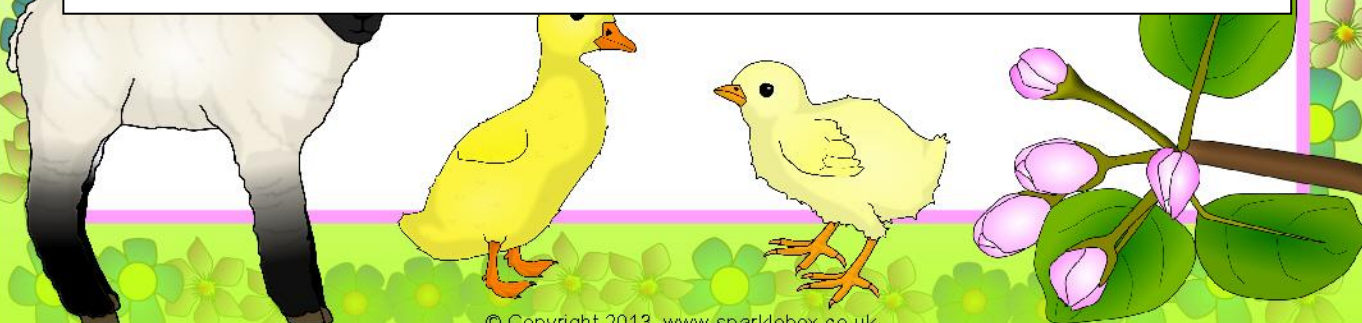
## Easter Experience
