This week the Year 1 children have been learning their 10x table. They have used concrete materials to help count in tens and even been writing their own 10x tables calculations!



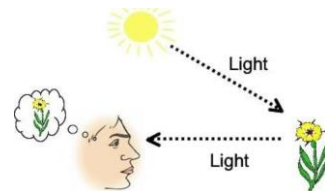
LKS2-Years 3 and 4
