EYFS

This week the children have been working in their colour groups for Maths and English. In Maths, the children have been using their sorting skills. They have sorted colours, shapes and numbers.

In English, we have read and discussed 'Kipper's Birthday'. We were amazed by all the information that the children remembered!

In Phonics this week, we have been focussing on the sounds - s, a, t and p.

Key Stage 1

In Science, this week KS1 have been exploring our 5 senses and linking them to the correct parts of our body.

In Geography, they have been looking at map symbols and matching them to the correct images, then they added symbols onto a map of our local area.

In Year 1, the children have been looking at the four parts of a friendship narrative and planning their own to write next week.

In Year 2, children have been looking at extended noun phrases from their text 'The Bog Baby', such as; 'strange, little creature'.



Lower Key Stage Two

In Lower Key Stage 2, we have been working scientifically to explore sound and how it travels through different mediums. We worked in groups to investigate how different materials create sounds with different pitches and how far these sounds can travel.







Upper Key Stage 2

In Upper Key Stage 2 we have been planned and begun our investigation into the conditions needed to grow mould. We have taken a piece of bread and placed it in a plastic bag. Each group has chosen a variable to change. Some will be kept in warm conditions, some in cold. Others will have added moisture of kept in the dark!
