This week in Year 1 we have been learning about place value to 50, looking at how many tens and ones numbers have and practising counting in 10's.

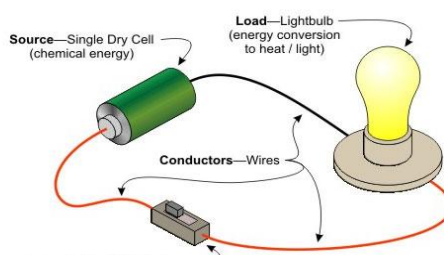
In Geography, this week children explored the school grounds to find the best place for a bee hive to go. We also looked at what human and physical features we could see.
