


Reception has been working hard on exploring the numbers 11, 12 and 13. They have also written some fantastic sentences using their phonic sounds.





### Upper Key Stage 2

Year 5 and 6 have made an excellent start to the Summer term. In Maths, Year 6 have been focusing on calculating the area and perimeter of rectangles, compound shapes and triangles. They have learnt to apply formulas:  $l \times w = area$  of a rectangle and  $(b \times h) \div 2 = area$  of a triangle. In Year 5, the children have been interpreting data from graphs as well as plotting line graphs from data they have been given. There are many superb mathematicians in Upper Key Stage 2!
