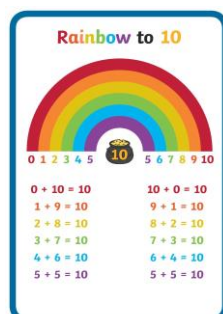
EYFS

KS1 have also been looking at UK sea's and coasts in our Geography lessons. We identified the different seas on a map and described the features of each sea.



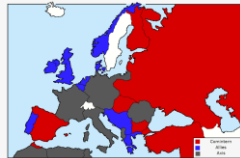
LKS2
